Be Safe Students

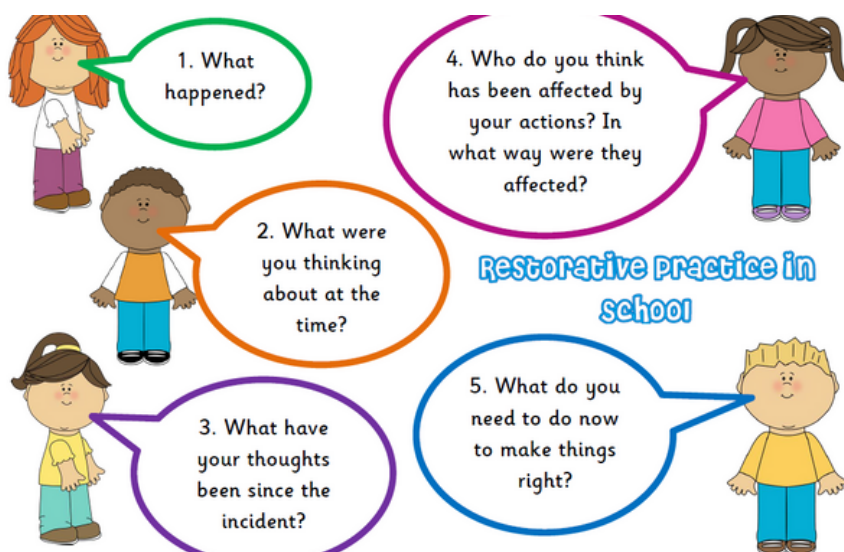
Be Responsible Learners
