
PTA Membership Update

2020-2021 Highlights

- Explorers was able to run both virtual and some inperson
- Teachers were able to provide packets, supplies and books to students through stipends
- Provided hula hoops, balls, and jump ropes to all students who needed for PE
- Provided over \$8K to families in need through Nishuane



Overview of 2021-2022 Budget

- Since students are back in-person but we are still dealing with Covid, we are trying to keep activities (and budget) as close to prior (normal) years as possible.
- As of 9/22/21 the PTA has \$77K in the bank account (thanks to fireball and increased fundraising earmarked for A/Cs when approved).
- Proposed budget would result in using \$15K from bank account (the majority would be for Covid related expenses and A/Cs).
- Working with administration to move forward with a phased approach to upgrading A/C in the building.

Presented and proposed the 2021-2022 Budget. Budget was approved with all in favor, none opposed.

11) Q&A (Chat log)

- a) Have you considered getting outdoor heaters as well? The heaters would need to be approved by Central Office based on ensuring that it meets proper safety measures.
- In addition to the 5 additional tents, there are two additional long tables and benches on the way.

- c) Are there any plans to improve the grounds and playground? Likewise, any plans to treat the grounds for mosquitoes? Treating the grounds is something that is done by the buildings and grounds department. Any treatments need to be approved by the district
- d) Can you discuss temperature limits to going out for lunch and snacks and any ability to opt in to going out in lower temps even if supervised by parent volunteers? Kids will be eating outside in 40 degrees or over.
- e) Explorers is before and after regular school hours? Yes, that's correct. There are a few classes that will be in the morning, most are after school.
- f) Explorers sounds awesome. Is there any possibility for classes for parent and child? Yes
- g) Question: after the 8 weeks of explorer classes, when will they be offered again? We usually start in the new year in January
- h) If you do the 5K you should ask Mr. Eder for assistance I'm sure he would love to help
- i) Another way of keeping in touch is the WhatsApp chat for each grade. I know there's one for 1st
 & 2nd grade. Is there a kindergarten one? There is not a Kindergarten one
- j) Will AC's not be addressed with ventilation upgrades?
- k) Is Fireball happening? If so, we will close the gap with that.
- I) What is fireball?:) Fireball is a fundraising event that happens every other year.
- m) Since heaters are complicated and will probably move slow, what about making sure all kids have good, warm clothes. Maybe something ahead of Holiday Giving coordinated with Ms. Williamson? We still have Nish Cares dollars too that can purchase clothes if needed.
- n) Can we ensure every child has access to explorers class?? No taking 2-3 classes per child
